CITY BUSINESS

1. Discuss and consider adoption of Ordinance 10-2018-349, an Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Crowley, Texas, amending the solid waste rates in Appendix A, Schedule of

Rates, Fees, and Charges of the Code of Ordinances; providing that this ordinance shall be cumulative of all ordinances; providing a severability clause; providing a savings clause; providing for publication; and providing an effective date.

Norm Bulaich from Waste Connections stepped up and thanked the City for their business. He also stated that the increase was based on the 3.5% Consumer Price Index. Several Council Members praised Waste Connections for the great job they have been doing for the City.

Council Member Jesse Johnson made the motion to adopt Ordinance 10-2018-349, second by Council Member Christine Gilbreath, council voted unanimously to approve the motion as presented. Motion carried 7-0.

2. Discuss and consider approval of a special warranty deed from the City of Crowley to the Crowley Economic Development Corporation, to correct an erroneous transfer from Crowley 100, L.P. to the City of Crowley, for 15 acres of land [being part of the J. Steele Survey, Abstract No. 1381, the S. Gray Survey, Abstract 558, the R.W. Waggoner Survey, Abstract No. 1618 and the John Lucas Survey, Abstract No. 932, situated in the City of Crowley, Tarrant County, Texas and embracing a portion of Tract II, being a 57.984 acre tract of land described in deed to Crowley 100, L.P. as recorded in Volume 14683, Page 20 of the Deed Records of Tarrant County, Texas], and authorize the Mayor to execute the same.

Council Member Tina Pace made the motion to approve the special warranty deed and authorize the Mayor to execute said deed, second by Council Member Jerry Beck; council unanimously to approve the motion as presented. Motion carried 7-0.
