Arctic Challenge
The Arctic Ocean is already subject to a number of governance systems. The 1982 United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea (UNCLOS) applies to the Arctic Ocean, and is a key legal framework for Arctic governance. The United States, which controls the eastern portion of the Arctic Ocean, is a party to UNCLOS. Other Arctic states are following the UNCLOS model as well. The United States has also established the Arctic Council, a multilateral organization for Arctic cooperation. The Arctic Council is a unique international organization that focuses on Arctic issues. It was established in 1996 and has eight member states: Canada, Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway, Sweden, the United Kingdom, and the United States. The Arctic Council has a number of working groups that address key Arctic issues, including Arctic science, Arctic cooperation, and Arctic law.
